Fleas:

To prevent flea infestation of the hospital and its' patients, all hospitalized pets are carefully examined for any evidence of fleas. If any fleas are detected, a single dose flea treatment will be given at the cost of up to \$26.00. This policy protects your pet as well as others.

Intravenous Catheter

The placement of an intravenous (IV) catheter is highly recommended for any anesthetic procedure. If your pet develops low blood pressure, or other complications of anesthesia, an IV catheter allows us access to a vein for fluid and drug treatment. *(An IV catheter may be required for some patients due to age, length of procedure or health risk factors.)*

The cost of IV catheter placement is \$51.00

Microchipping:

We also offer microchipping as a way to permanently identify your pet in case of loss. The DataMars™ microchip is a small computer chip which is implanted under the skin between the shoulder blades. The chip can be read by a scanner, allowing identification by all animal control facilities and most veterinarians. **The cost of this service is \$54.00.**

AUTHORIZATION FOR PRE-ANESTHETIC TESTING

Your pet is scheduled for a procedure that requires anesthesia. We would like to take this opportunity to recommend pre-anesthetic testing and explain why it is important to the health of your pet.

Like you, our greatest concern is the well-being of your pet. Before placing your pet under anesthesia, a veterinarian will perform a complete physical examination to identify any existing medical conditions that could complicate the procedure and compromise the health of your pet.

Because there is always the possibility a physical exam alone will not identify all of your pet's health problems, we strongly recommend that a pre-anesthetic profile (a combination of tests) be performed prior to anesthesia. The tests we recommend are similar to and equally as important as those your own physician would run if you were to undergo anesthesia.

It is important to understand that a pre-anesthetic profile does not guarantee the absence of anesthetic complications. It may, however, greatly reduce the risk of complications as well as identify medical conditions that could require medical treatment in the future.

The combination of blood tests we recommend for the younger pet (up to 6 years) is listed below:

CHEM 10 BASIC PANEL

Cost: \$99.00

- BUN, Creatinine, ALKP, ALT, Glucose, Total Protein
(kidneys, liver, diabetes, sugar, hydration)
- CBC *(anemia, infection, clotting, oxygen-carrying capacity)*
- Electrolytes *(Na/Cl/K)*

The combination of blood tests we recommend for the older pet (7 years and older *) is listed below:

Cats: CHEM 15 FELINE COMPREHENSIVE PANEL

Cost: \$129.00

Dogs: CHEM 17 CANINE COMPREHENSIVE PANEL

Cost: \$134.00

Includes all tests above, and:

- Albumin (Protein), Phosphorus (Kidneys), Calcium (Certain Tumors)
- Total Bilirubin (Liver), Cholesterol
- Amylase, Lipase (Pancreas) – *CANINE PANEL ONLY*



***We require minimum testing of the CHEM 10 BASIC within 6 months of any procedure for pets 7 years and older.**
